暢談音樂路——音樂總監李偉安專訪

1月11日，是一個寒冷的冬日，然而我們卻十分興奮，因為我們當天訪問了學校的音樂總監，也是我們的校友——李偉安（1994），得知本校音樂發展的新路向，實在令人振奮。

或許因為大家在讀書時都有參加學校的音樂活動，我們剛見面就聊得特別投緣。我們大談校際音樂節的今昔，昨日片段活現眼前，氣氛十分愉快。

樂團譜新篇 音樂節外新嘗試

談着談着，我們自然十分關心學校音樂部的動態，開始談到今年的新發展。從多方面的消息得知，我們小學的樂團不打算參加本年度的校際音樂節，從1978年起可謂第一次。李總監在專訪中細說當中因由。

李總監說：「眾所周知，我們學校的音樂部很早就創出了外訪交流的先河，第一次是1979年到泰國交流，而較近年的其中一次就是2010年到北京音樂學院的活動，參加過的同學均認為獲益良多，大開眼界。」反觀校際音樂節近年有很多轉變，在比賽曲目的選擇上取消了自選曲目的一項。於是每年的9月至3月，一整樂團的學生就圍繞着一首三分鐘左右的選篇，每星期練習超過五小時。



他說：「作為一個音樂人，眼見學生只是集中在這麼短的片段上，卻從來沒有機會演出完完整整一首交響樂作品，自然會有很多想法。」於是他想起以往交流的經驗，構思如何帶領樂團跳出框框，邁向新一頁。機緣巧合下，他通過其他音樂界的朋友認識了 London Mozart Players 這一樂團，他們也在尋找交流的機會。雙方交換意見後，大家一拍即合，促成了今年5月的合作計劃。

London Mozart Players 是一個很特別的樂團，從營運到演出，皆由團員一手包辦。同時，樂團十分重視社區及外展工作。李總監認為，能夠與倫敦最歷史悠久的室樂團攜手表演，實在機會難逢，想必對同學大有裨益。

交響樂嘉年華 攜手呈獻古今樂章

李總監介紹說，這將會是一個七十分鐘的交響樂嘉年華，既有傳統曲目，又有現代樂章，例如《冰雪奇緣》。London Mozart Players 將會在5月6日公演前來到香港，和我們的小學團員一起進行一個為期兩天的演奏工作坊。他們會一起綵排，增進彼此交流。因為沒有比賽框架的限制，選曲方面亦將有更大的自由度。

活動在香港進行，既減省了行程安排的行政工作，又能達到海外交流的效果，可謂一舉兩得。李總監興奮地提到，樂團將會演奏一些經典名曲，而且是全曲演奏，務求令學生能感受到音樂廣闊的一面，有一個全面的音樂體驗。更高興的是，梁校長也會與大家一起演出，進行獨白的部分。





作出如此創新的挑戰，難免會令人有不少猜想，但李總監卻顯得一臉從容。「事實上，我們在近幾年的比賽成績是有目共睹的，而評判的評語也指出我們的高技巧無可置疑。但是，正因我們有如此的本錢，不是更應踏前一步，領導學界音樂發展走出新方向嗎？」言談間處處流露他對學生的信心及遠大的願景。

當然，他也肯定了比賽爭勝對提升水平的作用，因此他希望這類活動能與校際音樂節交替進行。同時，他也希望藉着今次成功的經驗，推廣至中學樂團，提升大家的層次，令樂團更進一步。

聖保羅精神 同心合力齊向前

那麼，在推行上有甚麼阻礙嗎？李總監說：「很感恩，沒有。」從開始和中小學兩位校長提出這個計劃以來，得到的全是支持和祝福。活動也得到洲際酒店和通利琴行的贊助，在9月學期初的家長簡介會中，無數家長兼校友也肯定學校的方向。

他又特別提到本校音樂老師的貢獻，令計劃得以實現。他指出，這計劃其實增加了老師的工作量，但他們卻沒有半點懷疑，只是默默付出，實在難能可貴。他相信，這一切都是源自聖保羅大家庭的團結精神及互相信任。當然，他亦不忘呼籲校友的支持，因為這些小師弟師妹在音樂方面的成長路，是極需要師兄師姐的支持和肯定的。

經過幾個月的準備，李總監也觀察到同學們的轉變。他說：「整體音樂水平高了，視野亦擴闊了。坦白說，他們的練習時間不但跟平常差不多，而且要兼顧的曲目多了，但他們演奏起整首歌曲的時候卻很興奮，我覺得他們在這個音樂旅程上成長了不少，變得更有深度。我更希望他們有一次愉快的體驗。跟其他校友閒談時，他們談起昔日音樂交流活動時往往眉飛色舞。我希望他們日後談起今次表演時也一樣！」

「回家」夏季音樂會 合唱團以歌聲感動校友

在訪問中，他亦提及合唱團的動向。樂團有了這個大型演出的重要項目，夏季音樂會的擔子自然落在合唱團身上。言談間我們提及了吳悅瀚（1991），一位我們的校友及前音樂老師。李總監憶述幾年前合唱團在美國交流時，吳老師不遠千里來支持，因為實在很懷念我們合唱團的聲音！

今年夏季音樂會將回歸香港大會堂，正是我們當初第一屆夏季音樂會的起點，相信也會勾起不少校友的親切回憶。近年合唱團也作出了不少新嘗試，例如在校友會合唱團的演出中也見到我們中學童聲合唱團的身影，相信在今年夏季音樂會中，除了一種「回家」的感覺外，也會有些全新的體驗。

作為家長，我們也不忘趁機請教一些學習音樂的心得。現在的小朋友很早就開始學樂器，有些更是十八般武藝，但李總監卻強調，長時間浸淫更為重要。他認為，音樂造詣是一個長途的修行，只有多付出時間、努力一途，方能克服障礙。

他又以自己三年級及一年級的子女做例子，指出自己以身作則，並沒有過分催谷，他們也是循校內管弦樂學習計劃開始學習單簧管及長笛。「學校推行這管弦樂學習計劃，是希望為學習管弦樂的學生提供集體音樂演出的機會。這些機會不是很易得到，但我們希望通過提供樂器和導師等支援，令有心、肯努力的同學可以體驗得到。」他明白同學在學習過程中難免會遇到困難，有所迷惑，特別勉勵同學要在努力學習中尋到樂趣，繼續前行。

訪問完畢，我們各自回家，在腦海浮現出樂團過往一幕幕精彩的演出，也熱切期待着在未來一連串的音樂饗宴中，與一眾愛好音樂的校友再次聚首。

梁校長帶領初級敲擊樂隊老師及隊員出賽前祈禱

愛的教育（下）

上一期，我和大家分享了我與丈夫如何在神帶領下信主、受洗，活出生命的彩虹。這一次，我想與大家分享我如何活出一位基督徒老師的樣式，如何倚靠天父的力量，將主的大愛傳揚給我們的小羊。

作為老師，傳道、授業、解惑是我們的責任。作為一位基督徒老師，我們更加一項最重要的使命：牧養基督的群羊，宣揚主的大愛大能，讓我們身邊的人，尤其是小朋友，感受那一份從主而來的平安。當遇到困難、挫折、衝擊的時候，我們都深信只要對主有一份確切的信心，凡事必能成。但當人最軟弱的時候，要心中有平安真是談何容易？在我初信之時，已真真實實地感受到神的平安臨在，原來神在不經不覺間遣派了天使來協助我、扶持我。而我，亦因多次經歷交託和信靠，使我能從心煩意亂到心安理得，再到圓滿解決問題。我希望可以與學生及同工家長分享我的見證，傳揚主的大愛大能。

信愛

陪伴着我靈命成長的重要人物，除了是我們的前任校長李端儀校長、我的啟導老師胡偉豪牧師、我的丈夫孫文超外，還有我們學校的校牧樓恩妙老師。記得當我剛接任校長之時，面對大大小小的難題時，實在有些措手不及。正當我在徬徨無助的時候，樓校牧拖着我的手，與我祈禱，並以下面的經文來勉勵我：

凡勞苦擔重擔的人，可以到我這裏來，我就使你們得安息。我心裏柔和謙卑，你們當負我的軛，學我的樣式，這樣你們心裏就必得享安息。因為我的軛是容易的，我的擔子是輕省的。(馬太福音 13 章 28-30 節)

感謝主！祂差派樓校牧在我軟弱疲倦時來叫我要懂得交託，將重擔放下，與主同行！而現在，當我的同工或家長失望沮喪時，我亦會與他們一起祈禱，更以馬太福音 13 章 28-30 節的經文與他們共勉。相信這亦是愛的教育，是主大愛的教育！

我在上一期撰文中曾經告訴大家我希望當老師，是因為我愛孩子，也愛說話，愛與人溝通和傾談。接任校長之後，雖然仍有很多機會與學生及家長溝通，但與孩子們面談的機會實比當一位老師和班主任少。因此我在每個樓層設了校長信箱，標題是：讓小孩到我這裏來(馬太福音 19:14)。我希望能與孩子們心靈有密切的溝通，讓他們能與我分享快樂，分擔憂慮，更讓我能夠有機會與他們傳揚主的訊息。多年來回覆孩子的信已成了我的習慣，也是最大的樂趣。記得有一次，一位五年級的男生寫了一封信給我，告訴我他很不開心，恨老師，因為體育老師上游泳課不准他穿沙灘褲，他又買不到泳褲……其實上游泳課必須穿泳褲，又怎能穿沙灘褲呢？老師的話沒錯呀！但我在回信及與他面談時沒有說他的不是，反而教他如何以祈禱平息憤怒，從別人的立場看一件事，更以哥林多前書 13 章 7-8 節「凡事包容，凡事相信，凡事盼望，凡事忍耐。愛是永不止息。」去勉勵他。令人欣慰的是那位同學不但平息了怒氣，還親自向老師道歉呢！愛的教育，就是在生活的點點滴滴中。

CAREER PANEL ON FINANCE – BANKING AND ASSET MANAGEMENT

Following the success of our first career panel on Technology and Entrepreneurship, we had our second career panel on the financial industry with a focus on banking and asset management on 16 September 2017. Since banking and finance is perhaps one of the most well-represented industries of our alumni (maybe after law and medicine), there were over 60 attendees ranging from students to experienced professionals coming to the sharing session by our panelists and to mingle with our fellow alumni.

Our three panelists brought in a diverse insight into the world of finance. Christina Gaw (1989), Managing Principal of Gaw Capital and one of SPCCAA's executive committee members, gave us a personal sharing of her career path and advice on how current students and women in workplaces can distinguish themselves to progress in their careers. Ka-Hay Yip (1988), CEO of Bright Stream Macro Fund, shared his wonderful Wall Street trading stories with us and how it led him to join the buy-side and eventually to start his own fund. Godwin Chan (1996), Head of AIMS Private Equity, Asia, Goldman Sachs, gave his perspective from a senior level and shared his personal experience on how working hard and delivering quality work will open plenty of career opportunities for young professionals.

After the panelists' sharing, our moderator Wisely Ngai (2004) led a light-hearted discussion and Q&A session where our panelists shared with us their views on the state and future of the financial industry, career advice, and of course, investment challenges and opportunities. Many of the attendees also stayed behind after the discussion session to interact with our panelists and other peers with common interests.

We would like to thank our panelists, moderator and fellow alumni again for their participation, making this sharing session interactive, fun and insightful. We were happy to have received very positive feedback from our attendees. Our Youth Group shall continue to connect alumni from different generations and industries through such career panels. MARKETING CAREER PANEL – 10 MARCH 2018

CHRISTOPHER WONG (2009)

Ever wondered what does it take behind the scenes to create the gigantic billboard you see in Central or Causeway Bay? We invited 3 alumni speakers on 10 March 2018 – Samantha Wong (1989), Jennifer Ma (1991), and Renee Sin (1991) – to walk us through their journeys and insights on the marketing industry.

Samantha started the event by sharing about entrepreneurship in marketing. After working long hours for an agency (and missing lots of family gatherings), she decided to build her own agency and gradually became a trusted partner to the Hong Kong Government. Through hard work and dedication, she coordinated numerous unique government projects appealing to the mass market, producing interactive campaigns and creating an atmosphere for two-way communication.

Jennifer furthered the conversation by probing into the changing media landscape. She also started her own shop during the internet boom, hiring off-duty firemen as their first part-time employees for media monitoring. Through an interactive Q&A session with the audience, Jennifer illustrated how free newspapers grew and took the place of paid newspapers in ad spend, how Yahoo! digital ad spend in 2010 was replaced by mobile ads in 2017, and why TVB is still the major player from 2003 to 2017.

Renee switched the angle from agency to in-house. Speaking from her experience advancing from a local role to a regional role, she compared a CMO (Chief Marketing Officer) to the

conductor of an orchestra: “You don't have to know every instrument in-depth, but you need to have great breadth and range.” In-house marketers work closely with agencies, as they need agency partners to complement internal limitations, so as to create greater synergised value together.

During the panel discussion facilitated by Wilson Ng (2005), we discussed the competitiveness of Hong Kong in the global marketing arena. Hong Kong customers are still comparatively traditional, and advertisers like to ask, “Has our competitor done it yet?” Nonetheless, Hong Kong marketers are still favoured candidates for regional marketing roles due to our communication skills, global mindset, and “lion rock spirit”. The speakers unanimously encouraged young alumni to immerse in the China market to understand their customers, and learn from their forward-thinking in marketing and technology. Even though digital advertising is on the rise and costs considerably less than traditional media like TV, the speakers recommend a marketing mix for most industries – it balances risk and sustainability, and reaches the majority of customers more effectively.

Final tips from our speakers: So what does it take to be a good marketer? Perhaps not just a combination of talents in arts and sciences, but also a learning attitude, and maybe even a bit of entrepreneurial spirit – guess we at the SPCCAA Young Alumni Group were right to organise the Technology & Entrepreneurship Panel a year ago!

當音樂遇上文學—— 聖保羅男女中學校友合唱團 《HAYDN'S MARIA THERESA MASS》音樂會

聖保羅男女中學校友合唱團承傳了母校追求卓越、勇於創新的精神。除了力求高水準的表演，近年亦多番透過不同曲種（如與管弦樂團合作的大型合唱、無伴奏合唱等）及邀請來自不同音樂領域的舊生擔任獨唱/獨奏，展示聖保羅的音樂造詣。2017年11月11日傍晚，校友合唱團在香港演藝學院之香港賽馬會音樂廳舉行了《Haydn's Maria Theresa Mass》音樂會，在兩位指揮家和歌唱家黃日珩（1997）和劉卓熙（2008）的帶領下，再一次為觀眾帶來耳目一新的驚喜。是晚曲目精選了以莎士比亞詩詞改編而成的音樂作品及交響樂之父海頓著名的彌撒曲，為觀眾譜出了一場音樂與文學的豐富盛宴。

音樂會上半場由指揮 Apollo 黃日珩帶領我們穿梭莎士比亞的世界，窺探不同音樂編曲配搭相同文字帶來的奇妙效果。打開序幕的是作曲家 John Rutter 改編自莎士比亞著名喜劇《皆大歡喜》中的《吹吧！冬天的風》（Blow, Blow Thou Winter Wind）。淡靜如湖水般的鋼琴前奏響起後，清澈的女高音聲部把淒美的主旋律滲透音樂廳每個角落，再由各聲部一層一層交織着豐厚的和弦和旋律。淒冷蕭瑟的意象凸顯了作曲家感慨風的無情不及人世之寡情。一曲完結，硬朗的鋼琴聲驟然響起，一瞬間打破了前曲的淡靜淒美，變為鋼琴無情的敲擊和弦。作曲家 William Mathias 異曲同詞的《吹吧！冬天的風》用了全然迥異的風格，合唱團各聲部間充滿着半音和不協調和弦，與前曲充滿着尖銳的對比，刻畫了人性的冷酷比嚴冬更甚。

寒冬過去，歌聲響起，校友合唱團緩緩唱出莎士比亞的《能否把你比作夏日璀璨》(Shall I Compare Thee to a Summer's Day) 為觀眾送暖。此作品為莎士比亞最有名的十四行詩之一。合唱團再一次巧妙地用兩首異曲同詞的樂曲讓觀眾從不同曲風細味莎翁文字的意思。相比起兩首《吹吧！冬天的風》的強烈對比，《能否把你比作夏日璀璨》二曲（分別由作曲家 Nils Lindberg 和 James Q Mulholland 編曲）則像是由內斂和外放的兩個人讚頌夏日的永恆之美，不斷累積的感情至 Mulholland 一曲全然釋放出來，在多個響亮的F大調鋼琴和弦的襯托下把作曲家對夏日的蓬勃生機的讚嘆充分表達出來。

音樂會的重頭戲為海頓的經典作品《降B大調彌撒曲》(Mass in B flat Major, “Theresienmesse”)。校友合唱團展示了聖保羅引以自豪的音樂造詣：除了邀請到 Sanders 劉卓熙擔任指揮及聖保羅男女中學校友管弦樂團參與演出外，校友合唱團邀請了四位才華洋溢的校友擔任獨唱：女高音劉卓昕（2004）、女低音譚允芝（1978）和男高音宋狄樟（2008）；上半場莎士比亞曲目的指揮黃日珩亦以男低音身份再次登上台前。令筆者覺得最驚喜的是今次幾位獨唱表演嘉賓多樣化的背景：有專業歌唱家、也有資深大律師和正在攻讀音樂的學生，而且他們充滿自信、純熟地在台上展露光芒，與合唱團和諧地交織出美妙的音樂，再一次展示了聖保羅引以自豪的傳統。

都市綠洲 返璞歸真

在香港長大的都市人，有多了解如何種植蔬菜和水果呢？又有多少人知道自己最喜愛的蔬果在未收成前是甚麼樣子的呢？

去年11月初，校友會夥拍香港唐氏綜合症協會，一同參觀了基督教家庭服務中心設立於彩虹的「都市綠洲」。此活動既讓我們這些都市一族了解有機耕作過程，也能透過活動與唐氏協會會員交流，有撮合環保、共融主題的雙重意義。

「都市綠洲」是香港市區內難得的有機農耕空間。說真的，很難想像在彩虹這個人口稠密的社區裏，竟然有可以悠閒享受「農耕之樂」的地方，能讓我們充當一下「都市農夫」，親身體驗由播種到收成的喜悅。

當日「都市綠洲」的義工們為我們提供農場導賞。導賞團包括兩部分，首先是參觀實驗農莊，除了觀賞一下之餘，亦可以伸手摸摸不同的植物。例如，蔥和韭菜原來外表雖然相似，但摸一摸便能知道蔥是空心的，而韭菜卻是比較堅硬的。我們又能近距離聞一聞薄荷、迷迭香等香料的新鮮氣味。最令我驚喜的就是一種叫「臭草」的植物，因為從遠處已有「綠豆沙」味的飄香！





導賞團的第二部分就是參觀其他市民租用的農圃和場地的農耕設施。雖然農圃面積不大，但所種植的蔬果林林總總，有差不多六呎高的粟米，也有和手臂一樣長的秋葵（義工解釋這是為下一個耕作季節留種用的），也有蘿蔔、矮瓜、苦瓜、冬瓜、生菜等常吃的蔬菜。雖然種植需時，收成量也不多，但不少「都市農夫」都以耕種來調劑一下，把這小小的天地當作自己的「心靈綠洲」。

另外，為了推廣綠色生活和珍惜資源等訊息，場地展示了節能設施，包括太陽能和風能裝置，也有一部先進的廚餘處理機製造有機堆肥，為農圃提供有機耕作的原材料。

活動的另一個焦點就是與唐氏協會會員的互動。參觀農圃過後，校友和會員分成小組，利用現場新鮮摘取的香草製作香草炒蛋。我更發現，雖然我們平常覺得他們是有特殊需要的一群，但其實他們很多都具良好溝通能力和自理能力的。我們這一組有講有笑，分工合力預備材料。其中一位會員更自薦擔任廚師，看她拿起鑊鏟有板有眼，相信平日也有在家中下廚呢！

既然要環保，剩下的蛋殼當然也不能浪費。我們在蛋殼中加入少量泥土，再將薄荷幼苗移植進去，製作出簡單的「蛋殼盆栽」。義工讓我們在蛋殼畫上自己的心情。在我身旁的唐氏朋友想也不想，就畫上一個「哈哈笑」，在旁邊寫上「開心」兩個字。

在這「都市綠洲」裏享受了悠閒的綠色生活，又接觸到一群新朋友，短短幾小時很快就過去了。有幸能短暫離開繁華的市區，返璞歸真，用心體會身邊的美好！
